

C 5.2 A WEEK IN MY LIFE



C 5.2.1.

We are going to keep a seven day diary and in it we are going to mark with different symbols

- a) Activities we carried out as a **duty** and others we received as a **right**.



A. We keep a Diary

All the students are to keep a diary over a seven day week detailing the activities they took part in after school hours.

The following is an example which they should follow.

This is to be carried out for all the days of the week including Saturday and Sunday.

B. Rights and Duties

All the things we carry out during the day fall under RIGHTS and DUTIES.

Rights: are those things I am supposed to get from others.

I have a **right** to acquire an adequate education.

Duties: are those things which I am supposed to do for others.

I have a **duty** to help with the housework.

C. The result of Joseph's diary.



Read: Joseph is in year 5 of Primary school. He too kept the seven day diary, and from his diary we gather the figures shown on the following page. We observe how Joseph spent his time after school hours.

From Joseph's Diary.

6	Religious activities: mass, doctrine attendance at MUSEUM	8 hours	
7	Sunday bicycle outing with all the family	5 hours	
8	Visiting and helping grandparents both on my mother and my father's side	4 hours	
9	Sleeping	56 hours
