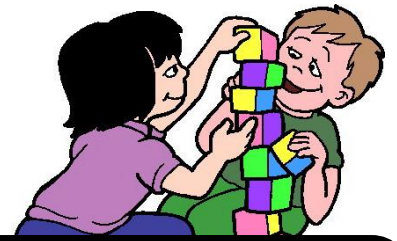


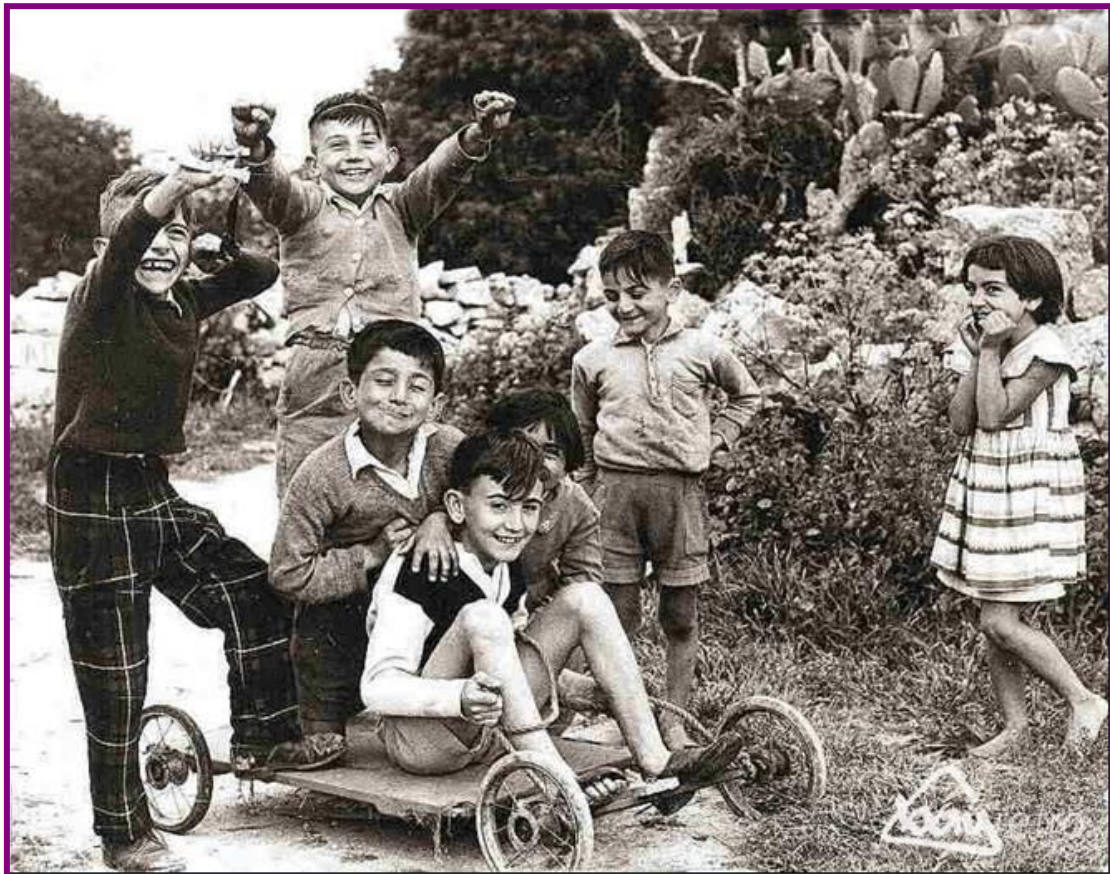
C 5.3 LET US PLAY
