6. The picture on the left tells us that it is dangerous to go into a place with this sign.



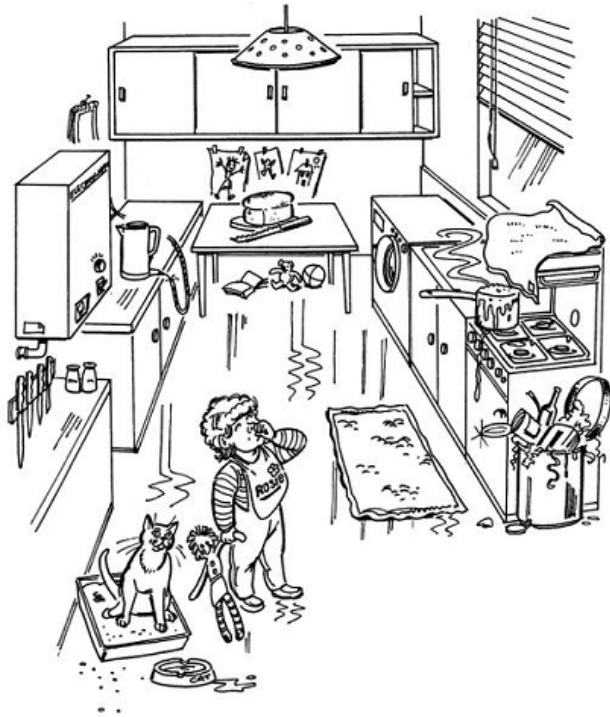
Mention one danger you might find yourself in if you do not pay attention to this sign.
