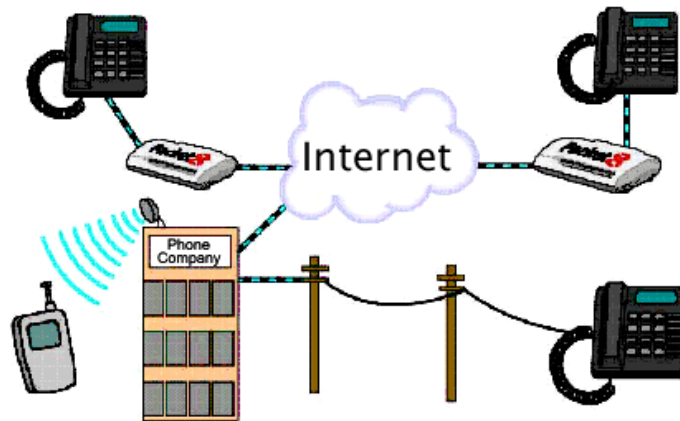

Sending a/an _____ is also a convenient way of easy and fast communication.

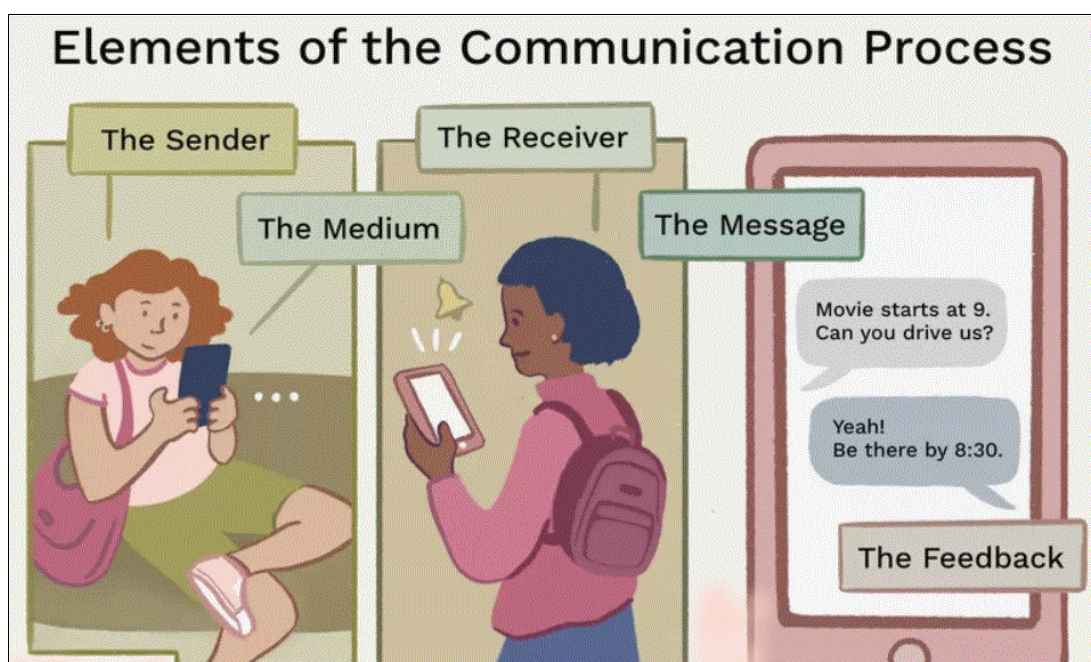
But technological communication can be _____ if not used properly. Many people are communicating with their friends only through SMSs and emails. This is called 'virtual communication'.

It is also important for young people to meet in groups, discuss, laugh and enjoy themselves together. This is called _____ communication, and we human beings need this kind of communication.









When we communicate with each other we can share ideas, we send and receive information, we ask questions, and we should also receive feedback.
