
Where are we found?



The Maltese Islands can be found in the Southern part of Europe, or at the lower end of the Mediterranean Sea. The word Mediterranean means 'central sea'. This sea connects with three huge continents; Africa, Europe and Asia.

The Continents and the Oceans

All the Earth's land mass is divided into six large areas called continents. In each continent we can find many countries. The continents are called America, Africa, Europe, Asia, Australia and Antarctica. These continents are surrounded by huge seas called oceans. So an ocean is a very large sea, much larger than the Mediterranean Sea which surrounds the Maltese Islands. There are five large oceans, which are called; the Southern Ocean, the Pacific, the Indian Ocean, the Arctic, and the Atlantic Ocean.




